# THE IMPACT OF YOUR GIVING YOUVILLE HOME MULTIPURPOSE SPACE PROJECT

On July 20, 2022, staff and residents celebrated the opening of the newly expanded and redeveloped Youville Home Multipurpose Space.

ith the generosity of community members like you – through anonymous and individual donations, a generous gift from the City of St. Albert, gifts in memory of loved ones, corporate gifts and support of our calendar sales and golf tournament – we raised more than \$817,000 and met our goal to fully fund the Multipurpose Space Project.

Originally envisioned as a multipurpose room and greenhouse space, the project evolved to focus solely on creating a larger, more accessible and inclusive multipurpose space with abundant natural light for indoor activities, therapeutic programs and social gatherings year-round.

The Multipurpose Space Project is comprised of four areas – the main hall, plus therapy, volunteer and equipment rooms. In consideration of the accessibility and safety of residents, visitors and staff who have a range of mobility needs, a ramp has been added to the external door of the main hall.

With 3,100 sq. ft. of redeveloped space, more residents, families, visitors and quests can participate in group functions, activities and programs.

Residents are excited to take part in many enriching activities in the new space including:

- cooking classes using the new kitchenette in the main hall
- · exercise, painting and drumming classes
- special events such as movie nights, tea & breakfasts and Happy Hour Fridays
- interactive games and activities including favourites like bingo, horse races and current event discussions
- multigenerational concerts and parties in collaboration with the onsite daycare

In addition to the space being available to residents, the facility takes pride in being able to share and welcome external groups and visitors to also use the space once it is safe to do so with COVID-19 precautions.
