LEADING-EDGE CARE – THANKS TO YOU

Your generosity is helping to bring leading-edge equipment and staff training, and greater patient and family comfort to the new Misericordia ED.

The state-of-the-art ED will feature more ambulance bays, treatment spaces, radiology rooms, private isolation rooms, mental health spaces and waiting spaces. The separate mental health area will include eight patient rooms, and is designed to offer privacy and calm with more light and access to a private courtyard. And nestled within the ED, the Edmonton Civic Employees Fund – Education and Training Space will provide an area where healthcare staff can practice simulations to shave seconds off procedures that save lives.
